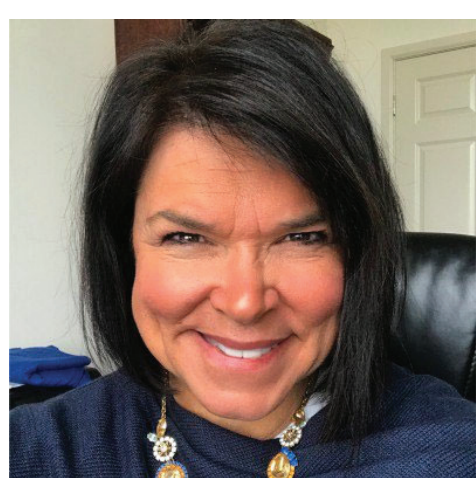
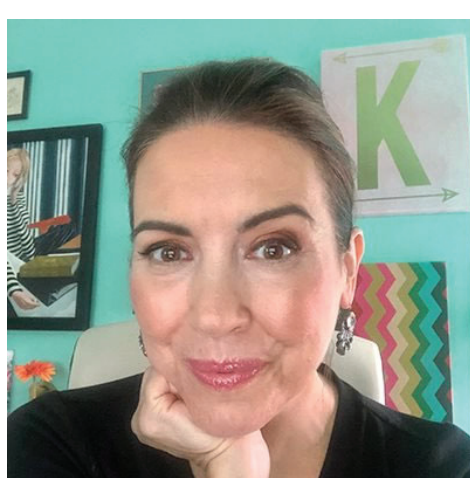

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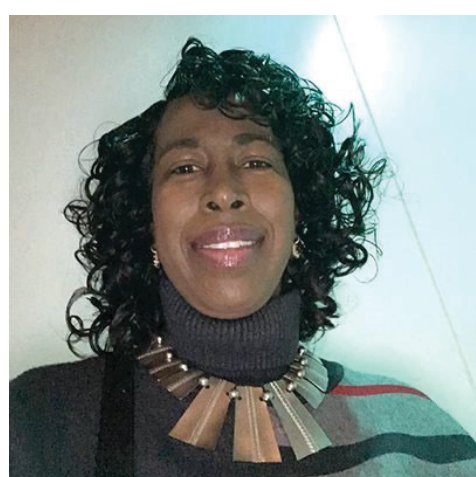
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FREE webinar for individuals with disabilities, families and professionals

The state and federal tax-free investment options are offered to encourage eligible individuals and their families to save private funds to support health, independence, and quality of life.
